The Big Fresno Fair is thrilled to welcome Nickelodeon's rockin' tweens, **Nat and Alex Wolff from The Naked Brothers Band**, on **Saturday, October 10th** to the Paul Paul Theater. The pop-rock band is the latest teen sensation to develop successful careers in both television and music.

The band was created by real life brothers Nat and Alex Wolff. Raised in the Lower Manhattan area of New York City, the brothers were exposed to a variety of music at a young age by their father, jazz-pianist composer Michael Wolff. As toddlers, they jumped out of the bath yelling, "We're the naked brothers band!" Heavily influenced by The Beatles, singer and keyboardist Nat formed the band The Silver Boulders while still in pre-school. Not to be outdone, younger brother Alex learned how to play the saxophone at the age of two and a half. After The Silver Boulders broke up, Alex developed his skills on the drums and joined Nat and his friends to form The Naked Brothers Band.

Nat and Alex's big break came when their mother, actress-writer Polly Draper, decided to make a "mock documentary" of the band as if they were huge like The Beatles. *The Naked Brothers Band: The Movie* included numerous celebrity cameos from the likes of Cyndi Lauper, Julianne Moore, Uma Thurman, and Tony Shaloub, who were all friends of Draper and Michael Wolff. In 2005, the film won the audience award for family feature film at the Hampton International Film Festival and was soon picked up by Nickelodeon, who developed a television series based on the movie. *The Naked Brothers Band: The Movie* aired January 27, 2007 on Nickelodeon followed by the debut of the show February 3rd. The series is currently in its third season. The band has released three studio albums that include *The Naked Brothers Band*, *I Don't Want to go to School* and *Face In The Hall*, as well as the Naked Brothers movie soundtrack.

Nat and Alex's talent and musical prowess has certainly put them on the fast track to superstardom. Bring your tweens out and don't miss your chance to see these up and coming rockers take the stage at The Big Fresno Fair on **Saturday, October 10th** starting at 2:00 p.m.
