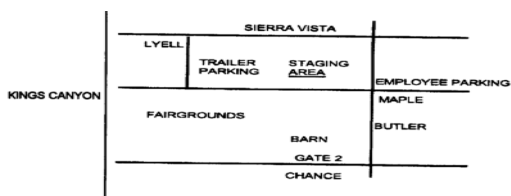
We are being mandated by the CDFA to do poultry inspections prior to coop in. The inspections will be conducted by a certified poultry inspector. Inspections will be conducted in the livestock staging area located NORTH OF BUTLER BETWEEN MAPLE & SIERRA VISTA AVENUES. There will be a tent set up where you will need to check in and have your birds inspected. Once they are cleared by the inspector you may proceed to the Gate 2 entrance of the fair located on Chance Ave. The Fur and Feathers loading zone will be on the north side of the northwest corner of the livestock barns (the new home of Fur and Feathers). You will be cleared to park there while you coop in. Vehicles must be moved immediately after your birds are cooped.

## **GENERAL RULES**

1. All Juniors Exhibitors must be dressed in appropriate attire, 4-H or FFA uniform or Independent attire, to present there animals for judging.
  2. Rules, definitions and judging procedures as prescribed in appropriate rule books shall apply to all district and county Fairs, provided they do not conflict with any other rules and regulations prescribed by the Department of Food and Agriculture. In the case of rabbits this shall be the Guide Book and Standard of the American Rabbit Breeder's Assn., Inc.; in poultry, the official Show Rules and the Standard of Perfection of the American Poultry Assn., Inc.; in Pigeons the Book of Pigeon Standards. Where no American standard is in vogue, the latest European standard will be used.
  3. **ALL SPECIES MUST BE APPROPRIATELY IDENTIFIED I.E. PERMANENT LEFT EAR MARKINGS,(for Rabbits & cavies); LEG BANDS (for poultry); SERIALLY NUMBERS CURRENT YEAR SEAMLESS LEG BAND OF CORRECT SIZE (for young pigeons); OLD PIGEONS MUST HAVE EITHER SEAMLESS OR SPLIT PRIOR YEAR SERIALLY NUMBERED BANDS. THESE IDENTIFICATIONS MUST CONFORM TO ENTRY FORM ON ARRIVAL AT SHOW.** Any duplication of identifications by one exhibitor in the same division must be eliminated and the change recorded on the judging sheet *BEFORE JUDGING*.
  4. Each species will be shown and judged in the proper division and class for breed, variety, age and sex ONLY. If no class is offered, no awards may be made.
  5. A judge may excuse an individual from competition because of temporary or curable defects.
  6. ENTRY FORMS FURNISHED BY THE BIG FRESNO FAIR MUST BE FILLED OUT IN DETAIL INCLUDING ALL REQUESTED INFORMATION. Additional entry forms will be mailed upon request.
  7. Make all remittances payable to:

- No exhibit will be cooped unless entry fee is paid in advance.
8. **Use separate entry form** for Rabbits and Rabbit **Showmanship**. A separate entry form for Large Poultry, Bantams, Poultry **showmanship**, Turkeys, Ducks, Geese, Pheasants. **A separate entry form** for Pigeons. **A separate entry form** for Banners.
  9. No exhibitor shall receive more than two cash awards in any one class. State Rule VI-6 applies.

10. Ribbons and trophies won at other shows may not be displayed on coops either as decoration or advertising. Other signs or placards will not be acceptable.
11. It is the responsibility of each exhibitor to be aware of what time they show and to be at the show ring on time, dressed out in show attire with your animal. **NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE!**
12. NO DISEASED ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED. Please examine animals carefully before bringing to the show. **EXHIBITOR feeding & grooming hours: 7 AM to 8:30 AM, 7 PM to 8:00 PM NO EXCEPTIONS.** No extended parking available. Feed passes will be available if you need to bring feed inside the Fairgrounds.
13. All exhibits are exhibited at owner's risk. The management assumes no responsibility. The management reserves the right to refuse an entry which is not in the best interest of the Fur and Feathers Department of the Big Fresno Fair.
14. The rabbit show is sanctioned by the American Rabbit Breeders Assn., Inc.
15. The poultry show is sanctioned by the American Poultry Assn., Inc. and the American Bantam Association.
16. In the pigeons **ONLY RECOGNIZED COLORS** shall be considered in "Any other Color" (AOC) divisions
17. ALL ANIMALS MUST BE IDENTIFIED IN DIVISIONS WHERE SPECIFIED. (I.E. VARIETY, COLOR, BREED).
18. Substitutions will only be allowed within the same class and **only two per exhibitor.**
19. Exhibitor may supply own crocks and/or feeders and will be responsible for them.
20. It is our intent to make your arrival as smooth as possible. **ALL BIRDS MUST BE INSPECTED BEFORE ENTERING THE FAIRGROUND.** All FFA, 4-H & INDEPENDENT Poultry exhibitors **MUST GO TO THE STAGING AREA** for inspection at the **NE corner of Maple & Butler** and will then be moved up to the Fairgrounds through Gate 2.

**If you wish to check on traffic before you leave home call 650-3292. We don't want you to wait in traffic. We need every exhibitor's help. When unloading is completed, remove your vehicle from the grounds. If we all work together, we can help to overcome any traffic concerns.**

21. Rabbit exhibitors unloading rabbits **only** may enter through Gate 2.
22. Exhibitors may supply their own water bottles (2 per entry) for freezing. Your bottles will be placed in cages to help keep rabbits cool.
23. The Department Office will be in the old Exhibit Office in the Livestock Pavilion.
24. Exhibitor must own animal exhibited the entire 60 days before the fair.
25. For pass information refer to Livestock section of the Fair handbook.
26. ALL ANIMALS MUST BE IDENTIFIED IN DIVISIONS WHERE SPECIFIED. (I.E. VARIETY, COLOR, BREED).

27. **THERE ARE NO CLASSES AVAILABLE IN THE JUNIOR DIVISION FOR PRIMARY 4-H MEMBERS. JUNIOR EXHIBITORS MUST BE 9 AS OF JANUARY 1, 2009.**
28. **Anyone interfering with the judging will be asked to leave the barn.**

**RULES**

1. Feature exhibit display provides an opportunity to acquaint the public with small stock (poultry, pigeons, rabbits, covies).
2. Feature displays shall be limited to one entry per club or organization
3. Entry form must be signed by the exhibitor in charge of the exhibit or club leader.
4. Only natural materials will be used such as wood, trees, rocks, plants, water, sand, etc. **NO** crepe paper is to be used. All decorative material must be flame-proofed and subject to inspection by the Fire Marshall.
5. Displays must be designed and installed only by the organization members.
6. **An animal showing signs of illness or disease will be removed from display.**

**SPECIAL RULES**

1. Entries close September 12, 2009. Entrant will be notified of acceptance and cage size.
2. There will be only two entries total accepted with Juniors.
3. For pigeons or poultry used for display see inspection notice on previous page.
4. Cages will be provided for display (1–6'x6'x6' or 1–6' x10' x6') with asphalt floor. Display must not exceed the perimeters of cage. First entries have first choice of cage size.
5. Exhibitors will have access to cages Sunday, October 4 only, 8:00 AM to 8:00 PM. Animals should be brought in Sunday, Oct.. 4 after inspection 10 AM to 2 PM.
6. Displays must be ready for judging Mon, Oct., 5, 2009 9:00 AM. Advise barn personnel if live animals are a part of your display.
7. Animals and decorative materials must be removed no later than Sunday, Oct. 18; 7PM-9PM.
8. Booths to remain in place until closing day of the fair. All materials used to be removed and the display cage left clean.

### RULES

1. This show is open to any 4-H member who is enrolled in a regular 4-H Dog project as of Jan.1, 2009
2. All exhibitors must be in complete 4-H Uniform.
3. This dog show is not an AKC Sanctioned Show. Judge's decision is final.
4. All dogs must be groomed by exhibitor. Dogs should not be left unattended on grooming tables or left in cars.
5. Uncontrolled or aggressive dogs will be excused from competition. Any member caught abusing their dog(s) will not be allowed to compete and will be excused from the show grounds.
6. Bitches in season will be judged in obedience and showmanship after the regular classes.
7. All members will be required to clean up after their dog(s).
8. Showmanship winners advance to appropriate Round Robin Classes.
9. **NEW RULE:** An Exhibitor may enter up to two (2) dogs in obedience but each dog must be in a separate class. (ie.) one (1) novice; (1) Sub-novice). An adult must be on hand to supervise the second dog.
10. **NEW RULE:** A veterinarian will be on the grounds to supervise check-in and conduct health inspections.



Activities helping others inside & outside 4-H and FFA.....15 pts  
 Each entrant will be asked to provide a list specifying their 2009 Big Fresno Fair class placings. Forms for this list are available in the Livestock Office and will be given to the entrant when their application is completed and turned in. Placings will be evaluated on a sweepstakes scoring basis, i.e., 1st place-5 points, 2nd place-4 points, 3rd place-3 points, 4th place-2 points, 5th place to final eligible placing-1 point. Champions & Reserve Champions to be listed.

**RULES**

1. There will be one winner from each livestock specie group exhibiting at the Big Fresno Fair.
2. Any 4-H or FFA member in good standing may apply for this award program. The signature of their 4-H Leader or FFA Advisor proves their good standing in the Club or Chapter.
3. Each entrant will be granted an interview. The interview panel will consist of a minimum of three individuals selected by the donor. Please see the Judging Scorecard for the basic criteria.
4. Each entrant will be scored in all areas on the scorecard. The interview panel reserves the right to conduct additional interviews or visit as needed for clarifications or ties. All ties will be broken by the panel. The panel may request input from Junior Livestock Auction Committee member, staff, advisors, and leaders.
5. Each entrant should bring a current Record Book to the interview. This will be reviewed by the panel; 4-H and FFA experts may be called upon to assist as needed.
6. 4-H and FFA members exhibiting livestock at the 2009 Big Fresno Fair may submit entry forms. All members are encouraged to apply. Supreme Champion and Reserve Supreme Champion Market Animal exhibitors will be prohibited from participating in this award program.
7. Entry form for Dairy Cattle, Goats & small animals must be received no later than 10 PM on Thursday, October 8, 2009 in the Big Fresno Fair Livestock Office
8. Interviews will be conducted in the Big Fresno Fair Livestock Office and will be done on a first come, first serve appointment basis utilizing an Appointment Sign-Up Sheet and taken in order on that sheet. Interview will be from 1 PM-5 PM Friday, October 9 for Dairy Cattle, Dairy, Goats & small animals.  
1 PM-5 PM on Friday October 16 for Beef, Sheep, & Swine.
9. All judging, scoring, and related matters are strictly confidential and will not be shared with any person. The panel may, at their discretion, share reasons for choosing a particular Champion, but not in any comparison to another entrant. Entry form must include a brief (500 words or less) description/discussion of the entrant's fair project. The description should start with the beginning of the project (purchase or birth of the animals) and continue up to and including the experiences preparing for the fair.

4. Auction Limits: Each exhibitor is limited to one market animal and one replacement animal. Listed below are the species and their appropriate classification.
